Additionally, information and guidance relating to employment service and workforce investment have been consolidated and will be available in our new "Jobs and Training" Web site.

There are six primary sections within the "**Jobs and Training**" Web site:

Overview

Overview of "Jobs and Training" and a summary of the other sections of the site.

Job Seekers

The Job Seekers page provides information on how to find a job, explore career options, apprenticeship opportunities, and where to find an office for all employment and training needs.

Employers

The Employers page provides information on how to find and hire qualified workers, tax incentives for hiring certain target groups, layoff services, and where to find no-fee employment and training services available throughout the State.

Workforce Partners

Designed for California's Workforce partners, this page provides access to State workforce services policy directives, information notices, resources, meeting information, and funding opportunities. It also includes information about California's Integrated Service Delivery Model!

Find Training

The Find Training page provides information on available training opportunities for California job seekers, employers, and workforce partners. It also provides information on available programs to help pay for training and where to get assistance to receive these services.
