The purpose of this Information Notice is to inform the Workforce Community of an American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) Fraud Prevention and Detection Training scheduled for September 2009. To assist with the requirement of accountability and transparency related to the expenditure of ARRA funds, the Recovery Act Inspector General, Western Federal Inspectors General Association, and the United States Department of Justice have collaborated to develop a comprehensive training aimed at preventing and detecting fraud.
