WORKFORCE TRAINING PROGRAM

The California Energy Commission (Energy Commission), California Workforce Investment Board (CWIB) and the Employment Development Department (EDD) will announce a statewide Solicitation for Proposal (SFP) for the California Clean Energy Workforce Training Program. This collaborative effort combines funding from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) for the State Energy Program, Workforce Investment Act Governor's Discretionary funds, and the Alternative and Renewable Fuel and Vehicle Technology Program established by Assembly Bill 118 (Núñez, Chapter 750, Statutes of 2007).

A Clean Energy Summit will be hosted by the Energy Commission, CWIB, and EDD to discuss the SFP and leveraging State and federal workforce development funding for the clean energy industry. The Summit is free and scheduled to be held at two locations:

The Summit will provide information on Industry Sector Strategy Approaches, an overview of the Clean Energy Industry, an introduction to California's Green Workforce Initiative sponsored by the Green Collar Jobs Council, and a review of the Employment Training Panel's current and proposed Green Initiatives. The CWIB will also review the planned approach for responding to the Department of Labor's State Energy Sector Partnership and Training Grants Solicitation.

The second part of the day, EDD will provide a review of the California Clean Energy Workforce Training Program SFP and address any questions.
